Thank you for your interest in The Louisville Orchestra! Auditions for Associate Principal Percussion will be held over **November 17 – 18, 2024.** 

This position is available at the successful candidate's and orchestra's mutually agreed upon earliest convenience. The 2024-25 Season is 34 weeks. The salary for Associate Principal Percussion is \$1,494.73 per week. This position includes instrument, life, and major health insurance as well as pension. This position <u>can only</u> be offered to applicants with United States citizenship or an appropriate work permit/green card.

## **Louisville Orchestra Audition Application**

Online application, including a 1-page resume, must be submitted no later than 11:59 pm EST on Friday, September 13, 2024. Additionally, a <u>refundable</u> audition deposit of \$100.00 is required from all applicants. The audition deposit must be <u>postmarked</u> no later than Friday, September 13, 2024 for your application to be considered.

Briefly, our audition procedures are as follows:

- Resumes may be screened prior to official invitation
- Preliminary auditions occur behind a screen
- The screen may be removed for the final round(s)
- You may use your own music, including electronic tablets, during the audition
- A detailed list of provided instrument specifications will be distributed as soon as it is available

If you must cancel after receiving an invitation, please do so **prior to close of business (5:00pm EST) on Friday, November 1, 2024.** Checks will be returned only to those candidates who attend the audition, do not receive an official invitation, or cancel their audition prior to this deadline. **All deadlines in the process are final.** Upon receiving your application, resume, and deposit all subsequent correspondence, including official invitation and audition time, will be sent via email.
