The Dallas Opera is a professional group of diverse persons of all professions and backgrounds. Productions rehearse during weekdays, evenings, and weekends for each repertory period. Collaborative Rehearsal Pianist and Assistant Conductors are hired on a per production period. Competitive compensation will be offered.

Assistant Conductor & Collaborative Rehearsal Pianist Application

First Round Application Requirements:

- 1. Current Resume, PDF Format only, with references included. Please indicate in your resume what languages you speak and understand and to what level.
- 2. One video link (YouTube or Vimeo) of a maximum of 5 minutes.
 - a. Examples of Acceptable videos:
 - i. Solo Pianist
 - ii. Collaborative Pianist where you accompany a singer
 - iii. Conductor of an orchestra, ensemble, or choir.

Live Audition Requirements for Collaborative Rehearsal Pianist:

- 1. Prepare one solo piano piece.
- 2. Prepare either A or B AND C or D, sing and play.
 - a. Puccini, La Bohème, Act One
 - b. Mozart, Le Nozze di Figaro, Act II, Finale
 - c. Bizet, Carmen, Smugglers Quintet
 - d. Strauss, Elektra, First scene.
- 3. The audition will include sight-reading.
- 4. Candidates will have to work with a singer provided by The Dallas Opera.

Live Audition Requirement for Assistant Conductor & Collaborative Rehearsal Pianist:

- 1. All the requirements of the Collaborative Rehearsal Pianist Section, above.
- 2. Conduct one of the two pieces below with a pianist:
 - a. Mozart, The Magic Flute, Ouverture and "Sprecher" Scene
 - b. Puccini, La Bohème, Act One

Candidates will be able to demonstrate the following:

- Excellent sight-reading ability music and languages.
- Experience in another professional opera or symphony chorus and/or strong academic or other non-professional experience.
- Availability to work a complex & rigorous rehearsal and performance schedule.
- Ability to work in a theatrical environment, including but not limited to the ability to perform in a variety of stage conditions including flat and raked stages, at stage level and on elevated platforms.
