1st round – video submission with application (anonymised for panel), deadline 10.59pm 30th September:

1st movement exposition from a free choice Romantic Concerto & the prepared extracts

Please label your file with the name of your chosen concerto.

2nd round – in person auditions to be held in Leeds during November:

1st movement exposition from a free choice Mozart Concerto & the prepared extracts

Trials – from November/December onwards, to include a chamber music round for Co-Leader candidates.

APPLICATION

Please submit your application along with your video recording via Musical Chairs by 10.59pm on Monday 30th September.

Please adhere to the following stipulations:

- You must submit the recording with video Musical Chairs will automatically remove the video content
- · You must not speak at any point during the recording
- No piano accompaniment
- All extracts and excerpts must be recorded within one continuous take, as if in a live audition, and uploaded as a single, unedited video (you will not be able to upload more than one video to Musical Chairs)
- Use a single camera and a single shot
- Visibly no editing (auditions found to have been edited may be excluded) and absolutely no effects are to be applied digitally
- · You do not need a professional grade camera, but please ensure your audio is not distorted
- When recording your audition video, use a space without background noise
- Wherever possible, position your equipment in front of a plain wall so that the main light source comes from behind the camera and that the image clearly shows your head, shoulders and torso
- Do not stand too far away from the camera or in front of a window
- Very reverberant acoustics are to be avoided, whether natural or artificial

Remember that the Panel understand the circumstances and will focus on your qualities as a player rather than the recording itself.
