Instructions for pre-recorded video

Deadline for submission: March 31st 2025

- 1. All applicants must submit a short audio-visual file of the required repertoire as outlined in the 'Repertoire Requirements' booklet provided upon application.
- 2. Your online submission will be assessed by the NSO shortlisting panel against predetermined criteria. If successful, you will be notified that you have been added to our list of deputy musicians in due course.

Please note: Video submissions will **NOT** be screened, and the panel will be judging intonation, phrasing and general musicality - not the quality of the recording.

Filming conditions

- No piano accompaniment
- Single camera
- Single shot, preferably full length
- Visibly no editing include a clock in your video (auditions found to have been edited may be excluded)
- Everything in one continuous take, like a real audition
- Your audition video can be recorded using a smart phone camera (i.e. iPhone, Samsung, Huawei, etc.). You **do not** need a professional grade camera equipment.
- When recording your audition video, try to use a room that has privacy with very little or no background noise.

Recommended sound settings

- Very reverberant acoustics to be avoided, whether natural or artificial.
- Microphones similarly must be within reason, rather than top-end and expensive.
- The Audition Panel will use their judgement and experience in separating out your sound qualities as a player from the sound qualities of the acoustic in your room.
- Please upload your pre-recorded audition onto your Musical Chairs account
