Only highly qualified candidates will be invited to audition. Auditions will be held in Seattle at McCaw Hall. Preliminary Auditions will start at 9:30 AM on Monday, April 14, 2025. It is possible that preliminary auditions will continue Tuesday, April 15, 2025. Finals auditions will be held on Tuesday, April 15, 2025 after the conclusion of the preliminary auditions. The excerpts will be identical for all candidates.

As part of the Final Audition, candidates may be required to return to Seattle later to perform with the Orchestra led by the Music Director.

Pacific Northwest Ballet values diverse perspectives, and life experiences; people of color, women, LGBTQ, people with disabilities, and veterans are encouraged to apply.

The PNB Orchestra is a per service orchestra. Employment benefits include access to health, dental and vision insurance plans. There is also a 401K plan.

Employment will begin September 1, 2025. For the 2025-2026 season, Assistant Principal rates will be no less than \$266.99 for each 2.5-hour service and \$320.40 for each 3-hour service.

There are six Repertory productions per season plus Nutcracker. There are on average 9 services per Repertory production and approximately 35 Nutcracker services.

The season usually runs from mid-September to early June. Repertory productions are typically scheduled within a two-week framework. Nutcrackers start in late November and finish at the end of December. All players are required to play a minimum of 70% of Nutcracker services but can opt to play all services.
