3. Handel: Messiah – No. 48 The trumpet shall sound

4. Mussorgsky/Ravel: *Pictures at an Exhibition* – Promenade, and Goldenberg & Schmuyle solos

5. Mahler: Symphony #5 – movement I, opening - #1

6. Respighi: Pines of Rome – Catacomb solo

7. Rimsky-Korsakov: Scheherazade, op. 35 – movement IV, letter T – U

8. Shostakovich: Symphony #1 – movement III, 20 to downbeat of 21.

9. R. Strauss: Don Juan – 8th bar of letter S – 3rd bar of letter U

10. R. Strauss: *Till Eulenspiegel* – #36-#38

11. Stravinsky: *Petrushka* (1947) – #135-#139

12. Tchaikovsky: *Nutcracker* – solo in Chocolate movement
