- Joseph Haydn: Cello Concerto No 2 in D major op. 101, 1st movement with cadenzas and 2nd movement
- One of the following concertos from the romantic era: Antonín Dvořák: Cello Concerto in B minor, op. 104, B 191 (1st movement) or Robert Schumann: Cello Concerto in A major, op. 129 (1st movement)
- One movement (other than Prelude) from one of Johann Sebastian Bach's Solo Cello Suites no 1-4
