Programme of the auditions (in orchestra parts – the obligatory passages have been marked in the music materials for download):

1. Double Bass Concerto – first part and cadenza from one of the following composers to choose from: Carl Ditters von Dittersdorf or Johann Baptist Vanhal (required is solo tuning).
2. Freely selected solo piece.
3. Orchestra parts:

  - L. van Beethoven – Symphony No. 9, part 4
  - W. A. Mozart – Symphony No. 40, part 1
  - W. A. Mozart – Overture from *The Marriage of Figaro*

  - B. Smetana – Overture from *Sold Bride*
  - R. Strauss – *A Hero's Life*
  - G. Verdi – Overture from *The Force of Destiny*
4. Sight-reading piece.
