Essential prerequisites

- Completed domestic or equivalent foreign university education or equivalent artistic skills

Profile of the ideal applicant

- The applicant is familiar with the special requirements of teaching at a college or university and is able to contribute to and promote current professional discourse through critical thinking.
- The applicant is particularly committed to supporting and advising students
- The applicant is able to work as part of a team, has excellent communication skills, and is very sensitive to issues of diversity and gender themes

In addition, Mozarteum University Salzburg expects a willingness

- to choose Salzburg as their residence
- to actively participate in the development of the teaching concept and the artistic life of the university
- to get involved in the university's committees and to undertake any management tasks,
- to get actively involved in the development of teaching concepts, the creation of subject-specific expertise for and with students and to contribute to the artistic life of the university
- to supervise artistic and scientific theses
- to get involved in the university's project tasks and organisational processes
- to show commitment to interdisciplinary topics and goals of university work (such as sustainability, gender and queer studies, third mission)

The professor's tasks are to include

- teaching the central artistic subject in instrumental studies

The remuneration is based on the collective agreement for university employees in group A1 and the basic level is currently a minimum of € 6,362.50 monthly gross.

This corresponds to an annual gross amount of € 89,075 (14 monthly payments). Both the salary and all other employment contract details can be the subject of employment contract negotiations.

We cannot reimburse **travel and accommodation costs** incurred as part of the selection process.

Mozarteum University Salzburg is striving for an increase in the proportion of women in research and teaching and, therefore, is very keen to hire qualified female researchers and artists. Women will be given priority if two candidates have the same qualifications. We are also keen to hire people with disabilities provided they have the relevant qualifications.
