AUDITION INFORMATION

We are recruiting for the position of **Principal Harp** here at the NZSO. Candidates should display the highest level of ability and musicianship to apply.

These auditions are only open to those candidates with the right to work in New Zealand for the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra at the time of application.

- Recorded auditions due by: Monday 16 June 2025
- Live audition practice day (optional): Wednesday 25 June 2025 (Wellington, NZ)

#### LIVE AUDITIONS

Candidates can bring their own harp to audition on or use the NZSO No.1 Harp. For candidates using the NZSO harp, a time will be allocated on Wednesday 25 June 2025 to practice on the instrument.

Live auditions will take place on Thursday 26 June 2025 in Wellington, New Zealand. Live auditions will be unaccompanied. Please tune to A440. Candidates will be advised on arrival at the audition which excerpts will be required.

#### **RECORDED AUDITIONS**

If you are unable to travel to Wellington, New Zealand for the live auditions, you may submit a filmed audition recording. Only recordings that follow the following requirements will be accepted:

- Audition recordings must be video <u>and</u> audio
- Auditions must be recorded unaccompanied. Please tune to A440
- Auditions must be recorded on the same day, in the same venue, and be recorded within the last 2 months
- Each individual audition item, i.e. each solo and each excerpt, must be recorded in one unedited single take without cuts, substitutions or effects
- Each individual audition item (solos and excerpts), must be submitted in a separate file, with filenames as per the Audition Requirements document
- We recommend using a high quality microphone in a professional recording environment.

Candidates who request to submit a recorded audition will be emailed a link to submit their audition recordings.
