The Alabama Symphony Orchestra has scheduled national auditions for the positions of **Associate Concertmaster (tenure track)**, **Assistant Concertmaster (tenure track)**, and **Section First Violin (one-year, possibly tenure track)** to be held on **September 23, 2024**. The auditions will be held at the Alys Robinson Stephens Performing Arts Center, located at 1200 10<sup>th</sup> Ave South on the campus of UAB in downtown Birmingham. Preliminary auditions will be held behind a screen.

Candidates should bring with them to the audition appropriate identification as required for Form i-9, Employment Eligibility Verification (such as a current US Passport or a Green Card or a Driver's License and Social Security Card). Please submit a **one-page** resumé (with instrument, email address, and phone number) along with a check for your \$50 refundable audition deposit to the address below no later than **August 30**. Resumés may be emailed if you would prefer that to mailing hard copies. After the August 30 deadline, you will be given an audition time by email. **Please white-list [asoauditions@gmail.com](mailto:asoauditions@gmail.com) to ensure that you receive this information.** Your deposit check will be returned to you when you check in, or it will be voided and shredded if you notify the ASO no later than **September 15** of your inability to attend the audition.
