- Shaping the artistic content of the season's programming with a strong focus on quality, innovation, and audience development, as well as overseeing the dramaturgical aspects in collaboration with the communication department.
- Negotiating fees and buyouts, contract management, and budget monitoring.
- Leading and coaching the staff in the artistic and stage management departments, with attention to process monitoring and improvement.
- Collaborating with the artistic committee, composed of orchestra musicians.
- Maintaining and expanding a broad international network of conductors, soloists, artist agencies, and concert organisers.
- Representing the Antwerp Symphony Orchestra within the (inter)national classical music scene.
