
# **AUDITIONS**

### **Auditions and Enrollment**

The audition process for the CSM Galicia Promotion Program is conducted online, allowing musicians from around the world to apply. Candidates must submit video samples of their performance along with a biography for evaluation. Shortlisted applicants will then be invited to an online meeting/interview with the selection committee.

Once accepted, enrolled musicians work closely with CSM professors to design a personalized program tailored to their artistic and professional goals. This collaborative planning marks the beginning of their preparation journey, during which participants receive guidance and support to ensure they are ready for the program's demanding opportunities.

As part of the program, enrolled musicians take part in an annual online session where they are considered for concert and recording opportunities that match their skills and artistic development.
