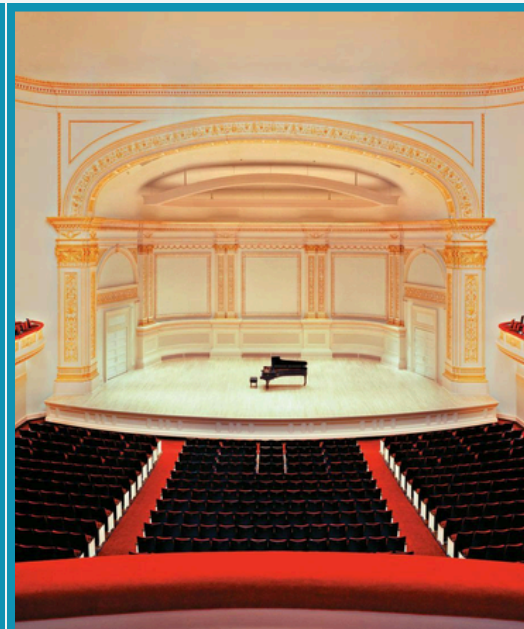
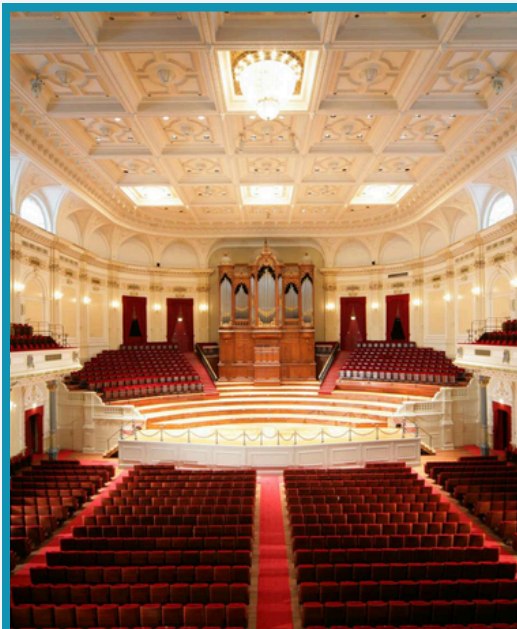
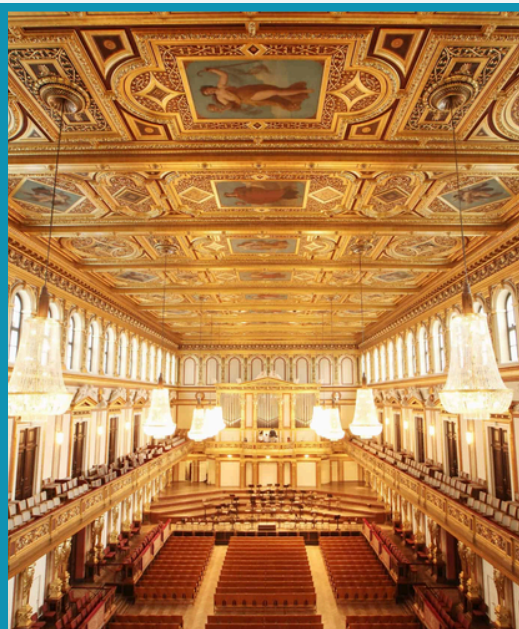

- **Piano Accompaniment:** A piano will be available for accompaniment during the audition. However, performing with accompaniment is optional, not obligatory. Candidates who choose to use accompaniment are responsible for securing their own accompanist.

VALGA, SPAIN

Notably, the area boasts two significant artifacts connected to the Apostle Saint James and Santiago de Compostela, making it a place of both cultural and religious significance.

Santiago de Compostela, just a short distance away, is one of the world's most important pilgrimage destinations and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Alongside its inspiring blend of history, architecture, and art, Santiago also hosts a vibrant musical scene, including the prestigious Real Filharmonía de Galicia. This renowned orchestra and other local music ensembles contribute to the city's rich artistic landscape, offering students unique opportunities to experience high-caliber performances close to Valga.
