

BEETHOVEN IN VILLA MARCHESE DE' FABRIS

MIKLOS PERENYI MASTER CLASS

The Master Class held by Maestro Miklos Perényi is dedicated to the complete production of Ludwig Van Beethoven for cello and piano (sonatas and variations) and addressed to already formed cello and piano duos. The Master Class will be held on 24th, 25th and 26th July 2025 in Villa Marchese de' Fabris in Begliano (Gorizia) within the framework of "Gorizia European Capital of Culture 2025" and will include a final concert by the participants.

Six previously selected groups will participate in the Master Class. Each will have to present a different work among those in the programme, so that in the final concert they will perform the complete Beethoven opera for cello and piano.

The Master Class includes six hours of lessons per day, on 24 and 25 July, (two hours of lessons per group). On 26 July in the morning there will be a dress rehearsal followed by Maestro Perényi. In the afternoon, the concert will take place, divided into two parts: the first part will start at 5 p.m., followed by a long break for the audience, and the second part will start at 8 p.m. All lessons and concerts will be video-recorded.

The duos will be selected by video. It will also be possible to send only one movement of the sonatas. Variations must be performed in their entirety. There may be a possibility that the selected duos will be asked to present a different sonata or series of variations from the one sent in order to realise the complete Beethoven production in the concerts. Duoists are requested to send a list of the sonatas and variations they have in their repertoire in addition to their CV.

Participants are also asked to attend the lessons of the other groups during the Master Class.

The curriculum and video should be sent to the following address: associazionevilladefabris@pec.it no later than **30 April 2025** following the re-opening of the deadlines; eligible candidates who sent their application by 30.3.2025 will be given priority in the ranking list for participation in the masterclass.

The Master Class is free of charge, as it is financed through European regional contributions (ERDF PR ERDF 2021 2027. Procedure no. 36. Type of intervention d6.1.1: Notice approved by Regional Council Resolution No. 2113, dd. 29 December 2023, and subsequent amendments and additions, concerning 'Incentives for the development of projects aimed at enhancing the role that museums, artistic-cultural collections and other cultural products can play as actors in local development'. Project entitled '*Villa de' Fabris. A project for the cultural and social promotion of the territory*').

Master's participant will have to pay travel and accommodation expenses. The Association will take care of pointing out places (bed and breakfasts, hotels and flats with special agreements) near the Villa where they can stay.
