Petras Geniušas

One of Lithuania's most prominent and versatile pianists, renowned for his mastery of classical, romantic and contemporary repertoire. Petras Geniušas collaborated with legends such as Rostropovich and Menuchin and is equally at home in classical concerts, drama stages, jazz, and crossover projects. He graduated from **Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory**, where he studied under Prof. Vera Gornostaeva.

A series of highest awards at prestigious piano competitions, including first prizes in the 1991 Y.C.A.A. International Piano Competition, and in the 1992 Palm Beach Invitational International Piano Competition, remarkably confirmed his reputation as one of the most gifted and accomplished pianists of his generation. Along with his developed musical taste, technique and sensitivity to sound, his innate curiosity to expand his musical horizons is probably one of the most valuable qualities of this pianist.

With performances in **over 40 countries** at the world's major concert venues like **Vienna's Musikverein** and **New York's Lincoln Center**. Geniušas is also a dedicated teacher, currently a professor at **the Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theatre and the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland**.

His accomplishments have earned him awards such as the Lithuanian National Award, the Ministry of Culture medal "Bring your light and Believe", and the Order of the Grand Duke Gediminas.



Ruxandra Humă

Ruxandra began her musical journey in lasi, Romania, earning awards at prestigious competitions before moving to the UK at 14 to study at **Peter Symonds College**. She later completed degrees at the **Royal Welsh College of Music** and **Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance**.

An experienced performer and teacher, Ruxandra has played at venues like **Cadogan Hall** and **St. Martin-in-the-Fields**, and inspires students of all levels with her holistic approach to music tuition.





Peter Kalmár

A Slovak pianist, began performing publicly at age eight and graduated with honors from the **Zilina Conservatoire**. He earned a Master's in Music from the **Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama** and has competed internationally, including a second-place win in the **Schubert International Duo Competition**.

He has contributed to community projects, including music education for disadvantaged children in **Cambodia**, and takes pride in nurturing talent and sharing the joy of music.
