PARTICIPANTS

What participant will get:

- Festival certificate including Professor comments on the final performance, to be handed on Aug.9th
- Trophy (Gold, Bronze, or Silver)
- Photos and video recordings

Additional participation condition:

Apart from the registration fee, we also need you to submit an application form. Additionally, we require one performance video, which may include multiple pieces. We will select one or two pieces from the video for the masterclasses with the professors. These selected pieces will also be performed at the Royal Academy of Music on the 9th. The remaining repertoire can be performed in other festival events, such as the public concert at the St Mary Le Grand church on Aug.4th and/or the private performance at the clock tower on Aug. 5th. The video which you submit will also be used to assess the level of chamber music repertoire. Chamber music pieces will be assigned to students 2 weeks after their registration is confirmed, ensuring they have sufficient time to prepare.

Dates:

- Registration opening: February 20th 2025
- Registration closing: May 30th 2025
- Latest date to arrive in the UK: August 6th for Masterclasses
- Exact date of masterclasses will be confirmed in July 2025

Note:

If any students wish to add an additional one-on-one masterclass for their instrument or different instruments, we can arrange this at the Royal Academy of Music for an extra fee. Our target participants are different levels of music students, advanced amateur musicians and music teachers.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT TERMS

1. Deposit Requirement:

- The participant must pay OPUS ONE a 50% deposit per student within 14 days of registration.

2. Final Payment:

- The remaining 50% balance must be paid no later than 60 days before the festival start date.

REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

1. If the Partner Cancels (Student Withdrawals)

- More than 60 days before the festival: Full refund minus a £100 admin fee.
- Between 30 – 60 days before the festival: 50% refund of the full package price.
- Less than 30 days before the festival: No refund.

2. If OPUS ONE Cancels (Festival Cancellation)

- Full refund of all payments made, or option to roll over the booking to the next festival.

3. Force Majeure (Unforeseeable Events)

- If cancellations are due to unforeseen government restrictions, travel bans, or extreme circumstances, both parties may negotiate a partial refund or credit towards a future event.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY

OPUS ONE is not responsible for the following matters, which must be arranged by the student:

- International flights, visa applications, and related costs.
- Local transportation (e.g., airport transfers, city travel, etc.).
- Personal insurance (including but not limited to travel and health insurance).
