4. AIM and SPIRIT

of the Jin Wang Academy Vienna

With the goal to build a bridge between the academic studies and the real music world, the "Jin Wang Academy Vienna" was founded, to prepare the special talents to become successful conductors, composers, soloists or singers for the future.

We developed a new system in 2 main parts:

- 1 The way of understanding music which the orchestra musicians and the audience use
- 2 A new "expressionism technique" to join the 21st century 's new challenges

We developed also a complete system of education, which combines music aesthetique, philosophy, literature and cultural history with the performance conception and "expressionism method". Altogether this education is very much related to today 's real music world, and leading to success.

We also organize seminars and symposiums for composers who are interested to preserve the meaning of the tradition and the value of classical music in writing their new music - for the musicians, for the audience and for the society – for a "neo-renaissance" of classical music in the 21st century.

5. AIM and SPIRIT

of the Special Workshops for Young conductors "How to prepare to join a competition?"

This series of workshops is specially made for young conductors who want to join international conducting competitions ...!

Our aim is to help young conductors to understand and to be better prepared before they are taking part in a conducting competition!

Many young conductors have got great talents and great ambitions to win the competition and to start their career...! But most of them do not really know ... "What is a conducting competition?" And "How to prepare yourself to face the challenge of a competition?"

.... Even for some young professional conductors who already have got lots of practical experiences and who already conducted some great concert performances, but even they could face some unexpected challenge and lose the competition in the first round ...!

And they don't know why...

And they become angry...

They start to criticize the jury and the orchestra...

They might be right ... in some cases! But the same story might happen in the next competition which they will take part in ...

Maybe they were not really well prepared? Or?

Maybe they simply don't know: "How to prepare for a competition?" Or: "How to act, behave, conduct and organize the rehearsal ... in a competition?"

If you are a good musician? If you have talent as a conductor? If you have big ambitions to win your future as a professional conductor? Then you should join us!

In this special workshop series, we will work with you in a very efficient system, which will be including:

A, Seminars with the themes as we mentioned above and more:

"How to prepare to join a competition?"

"How to understand the competition?"

"How to conduct and rehearse in a competition?"

B, Score Analyzing as a conductor!

6. The meaning of Conducting Competitions in Jin Wang's Life...

As a foreigner, hardly speaking any language, not knowing anybody, arriving to Vienna at the age of 27.... my first troubles were similar to those of many of you: "How to survive?" and "How to become a conductor?"

Many times, I was on the edge of giving up on my dream, similar to many of you, the dream to become a good conductor!

What really shocked me in Vienna was the way of thinking and the way of understanding music ... it was so different from anything I had learned and from my understanding and my imagination ... of classical music!

This big shock forced me to stay here and to study once again from the very beginning ...! It was very hard, but it was really necessary.

It changed me totally and I started to understand ... the "basic grammar and the aesthetic principle of Vienna tradition" and above all ... I have learned and understood ... the "meaning of music" ... not only at the Musikhochschule, but in the concert hall from many great conductors. Such as Maestro Vaclav Neumann, Claudio Abbado, Leonard Bernstein, Zubin Mehta and my professor Karl Österreicher and Leopold Hager ...

As a foreigner, I did not have any "connections", therefore the only way for me was taking part in international conducting competitions and ... I was losing and losing and losing ... and I started to think, started to understand and I started to re-train myself and then ... I started to win ... from small competitions to big ones ...

At the age of 30, I won the "Prague Spring" Conducting Competition and the "Dinu Niculescu" Competition in Romania.

At the age of 31, I won the Second prize in the "Fitelberg" competition in Katowice and the 3rd Prize at the "MTV Budapest" Competition in Hungary.

At the age of 32, I won the "Toscanini" competition in Parma, Italy, and the 1st prize at the "Nicolai Malko" conducting competition in Copenhagen.

Half a year later, I conducted Gustav Mahler´s Symphony no. 9 with the Swedish Radio Symphony Orchestra instead of Maestro Evgeny Svetlanov, who had canceled this concert due to his sickness ...and the orchestra played a "fanfare" for me ... after a long applause ...

From each success in competitions I got opportunities to conduct ... all of major orchestras in Czech, in Poland, in Romania, and in the whole north of Europe working as a professional conductor ...

So already 5 years after my arrival in Vienna, I worked as a professional conductor! Later I was invited in many different international conducting competitions as a jury member and I founded the BMI Conducting Competition together with the Bucharest Symphony Orchestra in (2018) and for the memory of my professor Karl Österreicher I created the "Wiener Schule" International Conducting Competition Vienna in 2022.

Of course, I was not ready after winning the competition. Of course, I made mistakes! And I suffered and I learned ...!

Part of the challenge I was facing to as young conductor ... or which every young conductor is facing to ... is simple: We are not prepared and ... we don't know "how to learn the things we don't know we don't know"!!!!!

Therefore, the mistakes which we do are inevitable!!!!

That is the very reason pushing me to teach, to help the young generation of talented conductors to prepare themselves to face their future challenges.

It was painful for me to lose a competition! And it was also painful for me to see a supertalented young conductor losing his chance ...

That is the very reason driving me to continue sharing my experience in workshops, masterclasses and competitions ...

We are a small organization helping a group of great talents. We cannot give you a big money prize and we cannot offer you to conduct a big orchestra ... But we can prepare you to find the right way to develop yourself, to win other competitions and to become a much better conductor!

In our masterclass, we will give you some very special seminars like: "How to prepare yourself to join a competition?" Or: "How to make an efficient rehearsal plan and how to do the first rehearsal?"

And we will also discuss some very important subjects which you really need as a professional conductor but ... which are difficult to learn in a conservatory ...

Do you really want to become a good conductor? Do you have the talent and willpower? Are you searching the better way for your own development? Please, join us!

- 9. In the situation of FORCE MAJEUR we will return 65% of your payment. The other 35% will be kept as a down payment for the postponed date of the same masterclass and competition and will be kept as 35% of the fee.
