OPERA CONDUCTING COURSE 2025 "Rigoletto", G. Verdi

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Extremadura Higher School of Music "MUSIKEX" is announcing the Opera Conducting Course 2025. This course offers the opportunity to conduct Verdi's opera "Rigoletto."
- The course will include the soloists, choir, and orchestra required for the performance of the opera.
- A regular pianist will also be available to work with the students and cast.
- A maximum of **12 active students and 30 listeners students** will participate in the course.
- Active students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Registration will be open from March 15th to July 15th.
- Non-active students will be able to attend all classes and practice sessions.
- On **Sunday**, **August 2nd**, in front of the Old Cathedral, there will be a final concert performance of the opera with the participation of all students.
- The course will be taught by **Francisco-Antonio Moya**, artistic director and principal conductor of the La Mancha Philharmonic Orchestra, musical director of Producciones Telón, and professor of conducting at the Royal Conservatory of Music in Madrid.

PLACE

The course will be held at the **Extremadura Higher School of Music** "**MUSIKEX**" located at Avenida del Valle, 23, 10600 Plasencia, Cáceres, Spain.

DATES

The course will take place between July 28 and August 2, 2025.

PODIUM TIME AND RECORDINGS

- Each active student will have **180 minutes of podium time** during the course sessions. This time will be distributed as follows:
- *30 minutes with piano
- *45 minutes with piano and soloists
- *15 minutes with orchestra
- *15 minutes with piano, soloists, and choir
- *30 minutes with orchestra and soloists
- *30 minutes with orchestra, soloists, and choir
- *In Opera in Concert, each student will have up to 15 minutes of podium time.
- Classes with orchestra, choir, and soloists, and Opera in Concert, will be recorded; this material will be available to students.
